ICS for single resources and initial action incidents is designed to teach personnel how to operate efficiently during an incident or event within the Incident Command System (ICS).

ICS ensures that the most pressing needs are met, and that precious resources are used without duplication or waste. The primary role of ICS is to establish planning and management functions for responding partners to work in a coordinated and systematic approach.

We have specific programs designed for each client, such as **Citywide Incident Management System (CIMS)**, **Hospitals (HICS)**, **Community College Districts (CCD-ICS)** as well as for **private businesses** and **organizations**.

This 32-hour, certified course includes:

- Introduction to the Incident Command System. This course describes the history, features and principles, and organizational structure of the Incident Command System.
- The roles and responsibilities of each function of the ICS team. Planning, logistics, finance, safety, liaisons, public information officer, administration, and policy group, all working together for a common goal.
- Various tabletop scenarios with guidance by subject matter experts. Our team includes instructors who have worked in an ICS during active shooter events, wildfires, and other major incidents.
