

# CA SB 390 Campus Security Continued Professional Development

As of July 1, 2021, California law requires all school security employees, regardless of hours worked, to complete a certified school safety training course in compliance with CA Senate Bill 390. This KSL, Inc. update course is taught by a Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) certified instructor and is certified by The Bureau of Security and Investigative Services (BSIS). This course meets the certification requirements of Ca Ed Code 38001.5 and CA SB390. This training fulfills the annual continued professional development requirement and is customized to reflect your district's real-world needs and recent updates in law and policy.

This is the update of the 3-day course and covers a wide range of current topics including risk mitigation, student crisis recognition, and case law updates—ensuring your team is informed, prepared, and operating in full compliance with California law. Attendees must have taken the 3-day SB 390 Campus Security course.

### **Sample Training Outline**

- Introduction & Objectives: This 8-hour update course builds upon the foundational 24-hour CA SB 390 Campus Security Training. It is designed to meet the annual continuing education requirements set by California Education Code 38001.5 and Senate Bill 390. The session begins with a refresher on key responsibilities and goals for campus security personnel, reinforcing the importance of ongoing learning to maintain a safe and legally compliant school environment.
- Legal and Policy Updates: Covers the latest changes in applicable case law and
  education codes that impact school security practices. Participants will also review
  current district policies and procedures to ensure continued compliance with CA SB
  390 standards.
- Behavioral Recognition & Crisis Response: Equips attendees to better identify
  students in crisis and recognize emerging threats through behavioral cues. Emphasis
  is placed on reducing risk and liability through timely intervention and traumainformed response strategies.
- De-escalation & Communication: Revisits and enhances conflict resolution and deescalation tools introduced in the initial training. Attendees refine their ability to defuse tense situations using calm, respectful, and effective communication techniques.
- Documentation & Reporting: Focuses on best practices for report writing, including legal considerations and documentation that supports clear communication with administrators and law enforcement. Attendees practice improving accuracy and professionalism in reporting incidents.
- Campus Threat Recognition: Strengthens participants' situational awareness by identifying patterns and behaviors that may signal a threat. Real-world examples and interactive discussion will guide participants in appropriate response techniques.
- Q&A + Distribution of Materials: The course concludes with an open Q&A session, allowing for discussion of site-specific concerns or policy clarifications. All attendees will receive printed and digital materials that summarize the course content and support continued compliance and effectiveness on the job.
