

CA SB 390 Campus Security Training

As of July 1, 2021, California law requires all school security employees, regardless of hours worked, to complete a certified school safety training course in compliance with CA Senate Bill 390. This KSL, Inc. course is taught by a Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) certified instructor and is certified by The Bureau of Security and Investigative Services (BSIS). This course meets the certification requirements of Ca Ed Code 38001.5 and CA SB390.

This comprehensive, in-person, hands-on 3-day course equips attendees with critical skills for maintaining safety on school campuses, including communication techniques, legal knowledge, and tactical awareness. Attendees will also become certified in the nationally recognized Stop the Bleed program.

The curriculum is based on adult learning principles and includes both classroom instruction and practical application. Participants will gain a deeper understanding of campus safety roles, legal responsibilities, and evidence-based practices to help mitigate risk and promote a safe school environment.

- **Introduction & Objectives:** Kicks off with a comprehensive overview of the course goals and the importance of safety and professionalism in campus security roles. Participants are introduced to how SB 390 training requirements align with California Education Code and the expectations for BSIS-certified school security staff.
- **Foundations & Legal Compliance:** Covers the legislative background and intent behind Senate Bills 1626 and 390. Instructors provide a legal overview of key topics such as search and seizure laws, mandatory reporting, and the clearly defined roles and responsibilities of campus security. This section also introduces POST and BSIS training standards that guide security operations in California schools.
- **Skill-Building & Application:** Focuses on building core security skills through communication and de-escalation strategies, the ability to recognize dangerous behavior, and accurate report writing. Participants learn essential concepts and techniques to enhance their day-to-day performance, including tools they can add to their professional "tool belt."
- **Certification & Practice:** Participants receive certification in the nationally recognized "Stop the Bleed" emergency medical program and certification for Campus Security per SB 390. The section also includes training on visual site protection methods, school safety protocols, and observation techniques. The course concludes with scenario-based exercises and a written exam to assess comprehension and readiness.
- **Q&A + Distribution of Materials:** The training wraps up with an open discussion to address participant questions and real-world scenarios. Attendees receive printed and digital reference materials, including policy summaries and practical job aids to support continued growth and compliance with SB 390.
